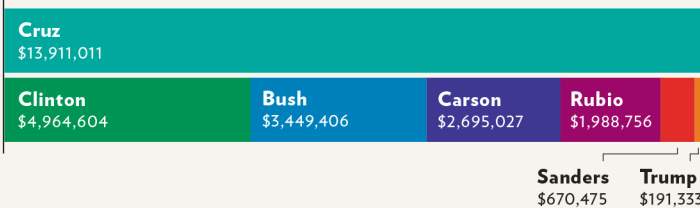
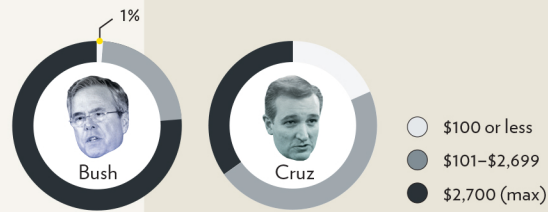


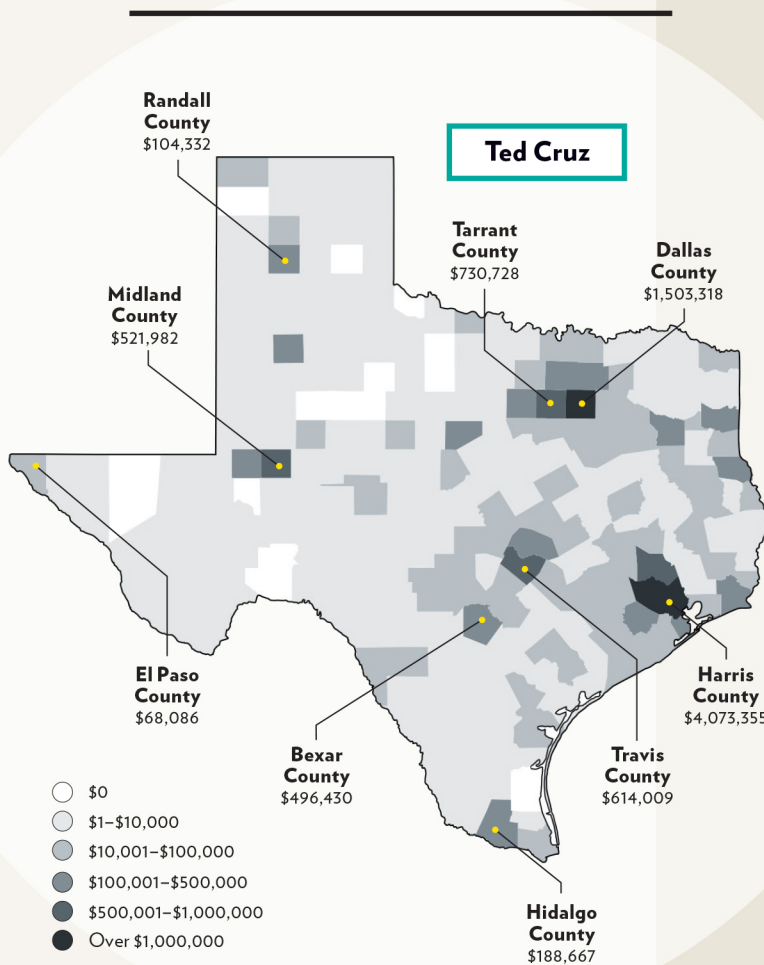
TOTAL TEXAN CONTRIBUTIONS



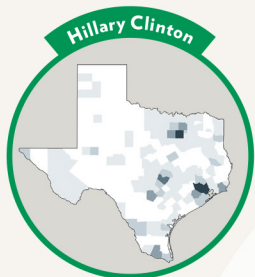
CAMPAIGN DONATIONS BY SIZE



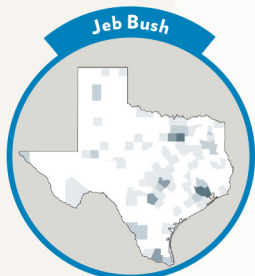
CANDIDATE DONATIONS BY COUNTY



Note: Because the Federal Election Commission organizes data by zip codes, not counties, some of these totals may have a very small margin of error.



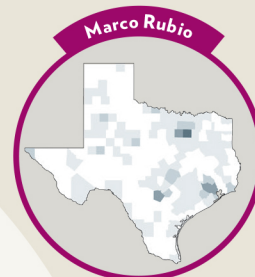
Clinton was the biggest fundraiser in seven counties, including Hidalgo and Travis.



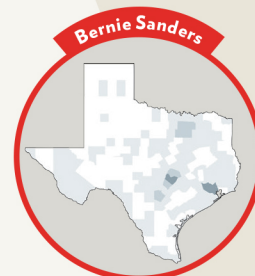
Bush prevailed in eight counties, including Cameron and El Paso.



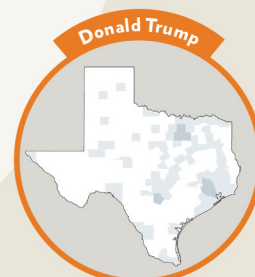
Carson was the winner in 34 small, rural counties.
